

CORN SNAKE

Behavior: Corn snakes are a popular snake because they stay small and are non-aggressive. However they can be quick and very good at escaping so having a good enclosure is a must. They come in a variety of colors.

Experience Level: Beginner.

Adult Size: 4-6 feet.

Life Expectancy: 20 years.

Ambient Temperature: 70F.

Basking Temperature: 85F.

Light: No UV requirements, leave the light on 8-12 hours a day.

Humidity: 40-60%

Food: Mice, juveniles will eat once or twice a week and adults will eat once every 2 weeks.

Minimum Cage Size: 30-40 gallon.

Habitat: Provide a hide and a branch or ornaments to climb. Provide a water dish of dechlorinated water large enough for the snake to soak in.

Substrate: Reptile specific shavings, mulch, bark.

Maintenance: Change the water daily and do a complete cage cleaning once a month.

Basic Requirements: Enclosure with a secure lid, heat lamp, undertank heater, large water bowl, thermometer, hygrometer, spray bottle, substrate, ornament/vegetation/hides.
